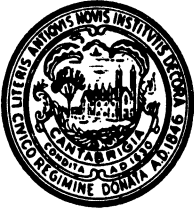

To the Honorable, the City Council:

In response to Awaiting Report #22 regarding an incident at Alewife on May 26, 1990, please be advised of the following:

According to Captain Martino of the MBTA Police, in the event that the MBTA Police is unable to answer a call for assistance, its standard procedure is to forward the call to the Cambridge Police Department. Neither the MBTA Police nor the Cambridge Police Department have records indicating a call for assistance between 11:00 p.m. on Saturday, May 26th and 1:30 a.m. Sunday, May 27th.

The Cambridge Police Department has a steady detail of two officers on Friday and Saturday nights at Faces, from 7:30 p.m. to 12:30 a.m. In addition, when the workload allows, the sector car is instructed to escort the crowd back to the MBTA station when the dance is over whenever possible.
