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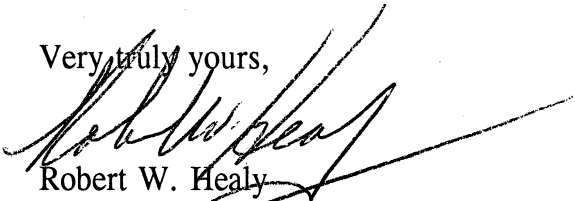

To The Honorable, The City Council:

In response to Awaiting Report Item No. 41, regarding the feasibility of moving the bus stop closer to the MBTA Station in Porter Square, Traffic, Parking & Transportation Director Susan E. Clippinger reports the following:

On October 5, 1995, the Traffic Department met with the MBTA to discuss the possibility of establishing a bus stop closer to the Porter Square MBTA Station. It is the opinion of both that a bus stop can be installed on Massachusetts Avenue just before Upland Road. This will not block traffic turning right onto Somerville Avenue or remove any on street parking. The MBTA will install its bus stop sign and a sign pole at this location.
