Dear Mr. Corcoran:

In regard to the City Council Order of September 10, 1973 and concerning the East Cambridge Residential Area: I would like to make the following report.

1. The Traffic And Parking Department has received permission and posted signs restricting Heavy Truck Traffic on the following streets in the East Cambridge Area:

Otis St. from Third St. to Fulkerson St.  
Thorndike St. from Third St. to Fulkerson St.  
Spring St. from Third St. to Fulkerson St.  
Hurley St. from Third St. to Sixth St.  
Sciarappa St. from Cambridge St. to Charles St.  
Fifth St. from Cambridge St. to Charles St.  
Sixth St. from Cambridge St. to Spring St.  
Seventh St. from Cambridge St. to Spring St.  
Eighth St. from Cambridge St. to Spring St.

I am also studying the other streets in East Cambridge with a view towards restricting heavy traffic.

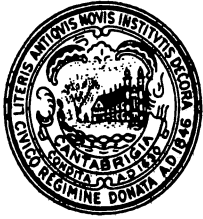
2. The Traffic Department is also making a study to determine the feasibility of a one way system in this area. We will meet with the residents of this area to discuss this and other related matters.
3. The Traffic Department is also preparing a Resident Sticker Parking Program for this area and as soon as the courts rule on the constitutionality of this program, I will put this program in operation.

I have discussed this with the City Council and will meet with the County Commissioners on the future parking program of the county courthouse at which time I will be prepared to make some suggestions in this area.


