An Ordinance
prescribing the mode of appointing certain
city officers.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the
City of Cambridge, as follows:—

The Mayor and Aldermen of the said
City are hereby authorised to appoint, for the
current and every succeeding municipal
year, the following City officers, to wit;— Field-
Drivers, Fence-viewers, Health officers, Fish
officers, Dealer of weights and measures, Sur-
veyors of Lumber, Measurers of wood and
bark, Hay-weighers, Dealers of leather and
coal-baskets, and Pound-keepers.
