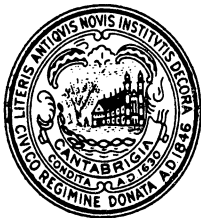

- No. 1: 7 Harvey Street is an occupied store. 7 Cedar Street was found to be open to vandals. We had notified the owner's son (owner deceased) by telephone earlier in February. Building was secured soon after. Owner (son) has contacted Duane Wrecking and just received clearance from the Historic Commission to demolish which will take place within the week.
- No. 8: 5 Corporal McTernan Road, owner was in process of repairing structure. We have requested a Board of Survey report and will follow through toward demolition.

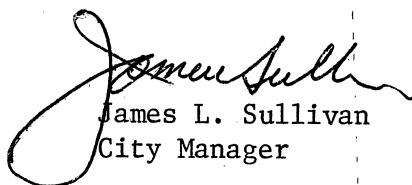
