WHEREAS: As has been the case with the Department of Public Works Award, this gift will enable ongoing monetary recognition of outstanding public service, a type of recognition, which is rare and much appreciated within the public sector; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council go on record expressing its gratitude and appreciation to Carl F. Barron for his gift to the City of Cambridge to establish the Ruth L. and Carl F. Barron Achievement Award for the Cambridge Fire Department; and be it further
