- WHEREAS: The Cambridge Sports Union has encouraged public awareness of the benefits of running for recreation and physical fitness; and
- WHEREAS: Since 1963 the CSU has organized and sponsored running throughout the City of Cambridge and in particular at Fresh pond so that all members of the family - men, women, children and masters (over 40) - may participate in this healthful lifetime activity; and
- WHEREAS: Organized running races at Fresh Pond under the auspices of the CSU have become a regular summer activity for the citizens of Cambridge to discover the joy and satisfaction of racing for pleasure; and
- WHEREAS: The CSU has made continuing efforts to insure that these races are compatible with other uses of the Pond; therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council of Cambridge endorses, commends and encourages the CSU's running activities at Fresh Pond, and expresses its hope and desire that the CSU will continue to organize and sponsor these activities on a regular basis during the summer months for its members and for all those who may wish to participate.
