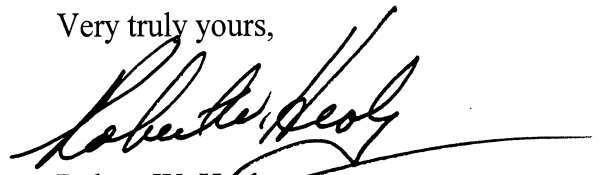

I am hereby requesting an appropriation of \$138,000.00 in the Grant Fund of the Human Services Other Ordinary Maintenance Account.
