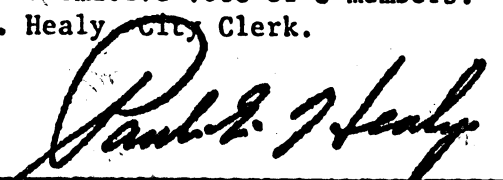
MAYOR RUSSELL

- WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of this City Council that Metropolitan District Commission School Crossing Guard Helen Patricia Boutiler of 51 Park Avenue, Cambridge, acted above and beyond the call of duty on Monday, March 26, 1984; and
- WHEREAS: Mrs. Boutiler, while crossing several school children, fell into a street depression and sustaining personal injury to herself but remaining on duty until the end of her tour, making certain the children were safely across her post which is at the corner of Huron Avenue and Fresh Pond Parkway, an extremely hazardous location for pedestrians, as well as vehicles; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record commending Mrs. Helen Patricia Boutiler for her dedication to duty and to the children of the area; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Mrs. Boutiler on behalf of the entire City Council.
