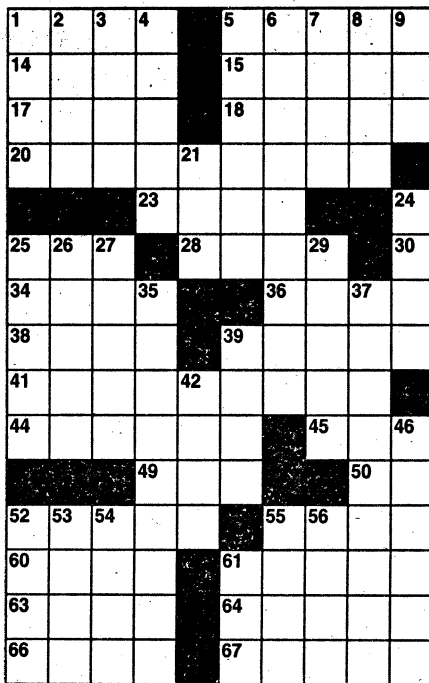
A funeral Mass will be celebrated today at 11 a.m. in Immaculate Conception Church, Cambridge.

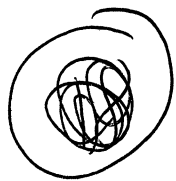
