WHEREAS:

It should be the position of all elected and appointed officials to tighten our belts financially so as to enable all of us to pass through this extremely difficult economic crisis, now therefore be it

RESOLVED:

That this City Council go on record requesting City Manager, James L. Sullivan, to voluntarily reduce his current salary of \$52,000.00 per year by 15.6% which equalizes the most recent pay raise which was received by him and which would bring his salary back to the amount at which he accepted the position.
