SUBJECT: Blue Ribbon Committee regarding
Care of laboratory animals in Cambridge

Cambridge Mayor Walter J. Sullivan has appointed Dr. Stuart Wiles to be the third and final member of the Blue Ribbon Committee, created by the City Council on September 21, 1987, whose ordered objective, among others, " ...is to determine whether or not adequate standards for care of laboratory animals exists in Cambridge and whether or not abuse of laboratory animals occurs..." .

Consistent with the Council Order, Dr. Wiles is " a veterinarian specializing in small animals who is mutually acceptable to the other two members " . He was the mutually agreed upon nominee of Dr. John Moses, Chairman Animal Care Committee at M.I.T., and Attorney Steven Wise of the Animal Legal Defense Fund, both of whom were appointed to the panel by the mayor in October, 1987.
