WHEREAS:

It has come to the attention of this City Council that the City's grant application entitled "Comprehansive Health Centers Program" has been disapproved by the United States Department of Health and Human Services; and

WHEREAS:

Such disapproval is tantamount to the elimination of all Neighborhood Health Centers throughout Cambridge, which will result in a major reduction in overall health care delivery to the citizens of Cambridge and in particular to those citizens who can least afford the cost of an office visit to a family or general practitioner; now therefore be it

RESOLVED:

That this City Council go on record opposing the severe budget reduction by the Federal Government in the entire human service area; and be it further

RESOLVED:

That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to the Regional Health Administration.
