An Ordinance Relating to the Water Loan.

Be it Ordained by the City Council
of the City of Cambridge: as follows:

Section 1. The Trustees of the Cambridge Water
Loan shall, so far as practicable,
invest all funds in their charge
in the bonds of said loan. Such
bonds so purchased shall be nego-
tiable only upon the order of said
Trustees who may so negotiate
them; and such bonds and their
coupons shall have written or
stamped upon the face thereof
the words "Negotiable only upon
the order of the Trustees of the
Cambridge Water Loan."

An Ordinance relating to the Water Loan,

Be it ordained by the City Council of the
as follows, City of Cambridge,

The Trustees of the Cambridge Water Loan shall, so far as practicable, invest all funds in their charge, in the Bonds of said Loan. Such Bonds, so purchased, shall be negotiable only upon the Order of said Trustees, who may so negotiate them; And such Bonds, and their Coupons, shall have written or stamped upon the face thereof, the words, "Negotiable only upon the Order of the Trustees of the Cambridge Water Loan."
