
REASON(S)

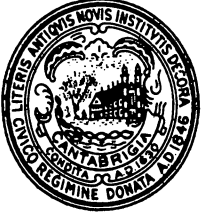


