- WHEREAS: Issues of municipal law before the United States Supreme Court, including liability and other financial matters, can cost every city significant amounts of money; and
- WHEREAS: The State and Local Center has been ably representing the interests of cities before the Court, winning several important cases; and
- WHEREAS: The National League of Cities, of which the City of Cambridge is a direct member, and other such organizations have announced a major drive to raise \$5 million to maintain this important service, and over 200 cities nationally have already pledged their support; and
- WHEREAS: The suggested contribution for a city of Cambridge's size is \$2,000; therefore, be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be requested to make this one-time contribution to the State and Local Legal Center.
