To the Honorable, the City Council:

Attached is an order requesting the appropriation of a grant for \$101,318 from the Massachusetts Department of Public Health to the Health Department Salary and Wages Account (\$60,043), Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$36,850), and Travel and Training Account (\$4,425) to provide funds for the Cambridge Health Department Tobacco Control Initiative.

Initiatives within the Cambridge Health Department will promote community awareness about the hazards of tobacco use and tobacco-free work places and public facilities, and enforce regulations and ordinances on clean air and tobacco sales to minors. Under the auspices of the Health Department, two employees will undertake a variety of activities around policy, and community education and services. These two positions will work as a team in conjunction with other groups addressing tobacco control in Cambridge, and will seek to develop broad based community support for change in tobacco control policies and behaviors.
