WHEREAS,

In the opinion of this Board, the public necessity and convenience require the removal of the tree ^s hereinafter mentioned, and public notice thereof having been given and hearing ^s thereon having been had according to law,

It is therefore hereby

ORDERED,

That the Superintendent of Streets be directed to cause the removal of the tree ^s as follows:—

Tree on west side of Inman street, standing in the driveway at entrance to City Hall lot.

Tree on east side of Bigelow street, standing in the driveway at entrance to City Hall lot.

~~One on Buckingham street, south side, the third tree west of Concord avenue.~~

One on Columbia street, west side, the second tree north of driveway at No. 97.

One on Ellery street, east side, the leaning poplar in front of premises of Maurice O'Connor, Nos. 34 and 36.

One on Forest street, north side, second tree westerly from corner of Frost street.

One on Frost street, west side, second tree northerly from corner of Forest street.

One on Sixth street, east side, second tree south of Thorndike street.

The expense of the foregoing to be charged to the appropriation for Street Department: (Shade Trees and Public Grounds.)
