WHEREAS: Firefighter Foley was later assigned to Engine Company Number Nine on January 10, 1961; Rescue Company Number One on September 10, 1961; Ladder Company Number Three on October 29, 1963; Aide to the Chief on May 1, 1977; Engine Company Number Nine on December 2, 1979; Aide to the Chief on July 18, 1982; Ladder Company Number Four on May 5, 1985; and Aide to the Deputy Chief on May 17, 1987; and

WHEREAS: Firefighter Foley was the Senior Firefighter in years of service at the time of his retirement; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its appreciation to **Firefighter Timothy M. Foley** for his many years of dedicated service to the citizens and to the City of Cambridge and wish him much happiness in his retirement; and be it further
