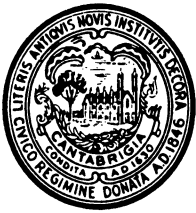
As soon as the study is completed we will report to the Council on our findings. I have also met with the Police Department on enforcing the existing laws in this area.
