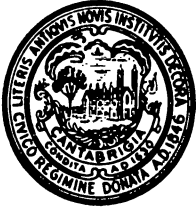

Attached please find for your review and action an order requesting the appropriation of \$3,500.00 to the Department of Human Service Programs Other Ordinary Maintenance account.

This appropriation will provide, through the Performing Arts Project, quality instruction to Cambridge youths through two program components: the children's dance project and youth theater project. The children's dance project serves 32 children from all areas of the City at the Graham and Parks School, and the youth theater project serves 36 children at the Fitzgerald and King Schools.

This appropriation will be financed through tuition received from participants.
