WHEREAS: Mr. Vogel credits the Phoenix Society for Burn Survivors as a very important aid to his own survival; and

WHEREAS: The Phoenix Society is being honored as a "Home Front Hero" in Plymouth next month; and

WHEREAS: The Walk-A-Thon will raise money for the Phoenix Society and will also mark the first day of National Fire Prevention Week; and

WHEREAS: The walk will start at Artesani Park in Cambridge, loop around both sides of the Charles River and end with a reception at the American Legion Marsh Post; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council go on record urging all Cantabrigians to be cognizant of the Walk-A-Thon in support of the Phoenix Society for Burn Survivors on Sunday, October 8, 2006 at Artesani Park, with registration from 9:00 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. and the walk beginning at 10:30 a.m.
