In the year One Thousand Eight Hundred and
Seventy Four,

An Ordinance in amendment of the Ordinance
in relation to Accounts and Finance,

Be it ordained by the City Council of the
City of Cambridge as follows,

Sect. 1.

Section 1. of Chap. 1. of the Revised Ordinances
is hereby amended by adding after the word
"unexpended" in the fifteenth line of said section,
the words and also, the amount, as near as may
be, of all outstanding contracts and bills
chargeable to each of said appropriations.

Sect. 2.

Section 6. of said Chapter 1. is also amended by
adding after the word "Accounts" the words
and the chairmen of the several Committees
shall furnish to the Committee on Accounts
monthly statements, as far as practicable, of
the amount of all outstanding contracts and
bills chargeable to their several appropriations.
