BOSTON, Mass., May 8, 1974

ORDERED, that, on petition of New England Telephone and Telegraph Company, dated April 8, 1974, for location shown on plan of New England Telephone and Telegraph Company, dated February 8, 1974, and indexed accession number 48678X, for underground conduit, cable, and one (1) manhole in the City of Cambridge, namely Monsignor O'Brien Highway beginning on the northerly side of said highway at an existing manhole numbered 26/192A and proceeding 100 feet easterly to a proposed manhole on the northerly side of said highway, and from the proposed manhole to be numbered 26/192B southeasterly for 50 feet to an existing telephone conduit that proceeds easterly to the Boston-Cambridge line, to be used for the transmission of intelligence by electricity, said location being under the care and control of this Commission, and found by order of the Department of Public Utilities to be required by public convenience and necessity, said plan and petition being on file in the office of the Commission, a hearing on said petition having been given by this Commission on Wednesday, May 8, 1974, at 10:05 A.M., at the office of the Commission in Boston, of which hearing due notice was given to all persons interested of the time and place by publishing a copy of said petition and the order of notice issued thereon by this Commission in newspapers published in the City of Cambridge, being the city in which the location petitioned for would lie, the first publication having been made at least fourteen days prior to the date of said hearing, and it appearing, in the opinion of this Commission, that public convenience and necessity so require, said New England Telephone and Telegraph Company is hereby granted a location for said underground conduit, cable and one (1) manhole, in said Monsignor O'Brien Highway, to the extent and upon the terms, conditions, and obligations hereinafter specified, the same being such as the public necessity and a due regard for the rights of the Commonwealth require, namely:-

1. The New England Telephone and Telegraph Company shall conform to all provisions of law applicable to the exercise of the rights and performance of the work under this grant and to the rules and regulations of the Metropolitan District Commission.

2. The New England Telephone and Telegraph Company shall do the work of installing said underground conduit, cable, and one (1) manhole, in the location hereby granted sub-

ject to the approval of the Director of Park Engineering of the Commission as to time, manner, and in all other respects.

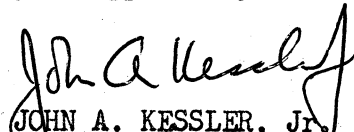
3. The New England Telephone and Telegraph Company shall indemnify and save harmless the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and the Metropolitan District Commission from any damage it or they may sustain or be required to pay arising out of the exercise by said Company or any of its employees in connection with the work done hereunder.

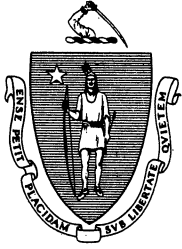
4. The New England Telephone and Telegraph Company shall protect and maintain all trees, drainage, or water pipes, and all appurtenances or structures either above or below the surface of the ground over which this location lies, and upon completion of the work shall restore the surface of the ground to the condition in which it was at the time of this grant, and in a manner satisfactory to said Director of Park Engineering of the Commission, and shall maintain the surface of the ground and the location throughout in such condition to the satisfaction of said Director.

5. The New England Telephone and Telegraph Company shall place and maintain proper barriers at all times and from the beginning of twilight through the whole of every night sufficient lights to protect the public from injury or damage during the progress of the work under this grant or during repairs upon said underground conduit, cable, and manhole, and work on the location which may hereafter become necessary.

6. No work shall be done under this grant without first obtaining a permit therefor from said Director of Park Engineering and subject to conditions imposed by him.

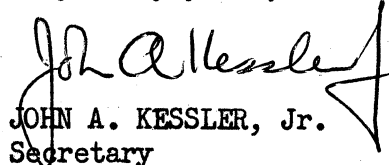
