

City of Cambridge.

In Board of Aldermen, Dec. 23^d 1879.

The Committee of conference on the part of this board in the matter of certain amendments proposed by the board of aldermen to the new revision of the city ordinances, in which amendments the common council has non-concurred, this board subsequently adhering,

Reports

That your Committee has conferred with a similar committee of the other branch, and the two committees have agreed unanimously to recommend as follows, namely:-

That the board of aldermen recode from its amendment to Chapter 1, Section 4, on page 54, 6th line from the bottom, which strikes out the words "joint committee on roads and bridges" and inserts the words "committee on roads and bridges on the part of the board of aldermen".

That the board of aldermen recode from its amendment to Chapter 3, Section 6, which added at the end of the 10th line on page 67, the words: "and no chimney shall be supported

" on a post or column, except by special per-
mission of the city engineer."

That upon the amendments to the ordinance relating to "Police", Chapter 26, page 102, both boards recede, and that the following new section be adopted as section 1. namely:

Section 1. "The police department shall consist of a chief of police, three captains of police, one for each police district, one captain of night police, six sergeants of police and such number of detectives and policemen as the board of aldermen with the approval of the mayor shall deem necessary.

" On or after the first Monday in the month of January in the year 1880, their appointment shall be made in the following manner, namely: the mayor first nominating them for their respective ranks and the board of aldermen concurring therein; and they shall severally hold their respective offices until removed by the mayor and aldermen"

That the board of aldermen recede from its amendment to Section 2 of said Chapter 26, page 102, last line but one, which inserted after the word "police" the words, "and they may be removed at the pleasure of the mayor with the concurrence of the board of aldermen"

That the board of aldermen recede from its amendment to Chapter 36, Section 9, on page 120, which strikes out, in the 3^d line of said section the words "joint committee on roads and bridges" and inserts the words "committee above mentioned"

That the 2^d line of said 9th section on p. 120 be further amended by striking out the words: "under the direction of" and by inserting the word: "with". Also, to amend in the 3^d line of said section by striking out the word "necessary" and inserting the word "authorized"
