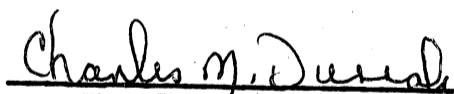

Power of Attorney

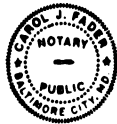
