- WHEREAS: A young child was injured this past week by a fall from a slide at the St. Mary Road Playground; and
- WHEREAS: Injuries from playground slides are often aggravated when the ground underneath the slides is covered with cement or asphalt; therefor be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be requested to investigate the feasibility of using sand, grass or some other suitable ground cover under slides in Cambridge playground areas; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be requested to consult with the City Solicitor regarding the City's liability in these cases and whether damages might be mitigated by use of a softer ground cover rather than cement or asphalt.
