Dear Councillors:

The Cambridge School of Culinary Arts is located at 2020 Massachusetts Avenue and owns the whole of a large parking lot in the rear of its building. During the past month the school has parked its van, license #137111, every single day, night and weekend on Regent Street. It was parked in the same spot for 2 consecutive weeks. This past weekend it finally relocated to another part of the street at which time it was jutting out so dangerously it was difficult to drive by it without fear of scraping or a collision.

The school has been unresponsive to requests to place the van where it properly belongs, in their parking lot. They are freeing their parking lot for student use at the expense of Regent Street residents who are already burdened by a serious parking problem in Porter Square. We are aware a resident parking sticker was issued to the school and is being rescinded because the school was not entitled to it. We request the retrieval of the school's sticker be expedited to prohibit their constant use of resident spaces.

In addition, to ease Cambridge's parking problems, we respectfully suggest that resident stickers cease to be issued to businesses that have parking lots and that those currently issued be rescinded.
