requests your Honorable body
to take into consideration -
the expediency, of removing the
obstructions, in the Public High-
way in the shape of trees on
the westerly side of Inman,
between Harvard and Main
Streets - said trees extend beyond
the curb stone, from one to two
feet - thereby endangering the
life, and limb of those who
drive through that Thoroughfare
and rendering the City liable
to a bill of costs - if there are
any doubts in the minds
of your Honorable Body,

as to your power to cause
said obstructions to be
removed, the undersigned
prays, that it be referred
to the City Solicitor, with
full power to cause the
same to be removed
