To the Honorable, the Mayor, and Aldermen,
of the City of Cambridge,

The undersigned respectfully prays represents that she has purchased land adjoining her estate on Buckingham Street, being the land on each side of Healey Street to Parker Street so called. Said land is so low that it cannot be drained into the sewer in Buckingham Street. If her land could be raised by the depositing thereon of the ashes collected in that neighborhood, — in itself a matter of convenience to the Superintendent of Streets, — it would enable her to drain said land through the sewer in Parker Street so called into the Buckingham Street sewer.

Wherefore she prays that the Superintendent of Streets may be authorized to deposit upon her land such ashes and waste materials as may be collected in that neighborhood and can be so used without detriment to the interests of the City, and with advantage to the estate in the vicinity.
