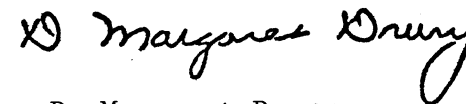

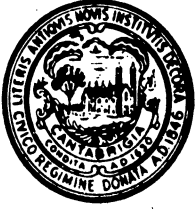

To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting an appropriation of \$22,000.00 in the Grant Fund of the Department of Human Services Salary and Wages Account (\$2,037.00) and Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$19,963.00). The Central Artery/Tunnel Project through the Massachusetts Highway Department has awarded funds to the Office of Workforce Development for the purpose of providing oversight, evaluation and program support to the partners in the Cambridge CA/T Collaborative: ERI, Computer-Ed, and East End House. CA/T funds support a computer skills training program and recruitment of candidates to the Apprenticeship Preparedness Program.
