Pursuant to your recent petition on behalf of the Cambridge Farmers' Market, requesting permission to conduct the Market from July 10th through November 27th, 1989, utilizing the twenty parking spaces in the City-owned parking lot at Bishop Allen Drive and Norfolk Street, please be advised that the City Council, at its meeting of Monday, June 19, 1989 granted your request.

With regard to your request for a banner, enclosed you will find an un-executed bond form to bring to your insurance company for processing. After the bond has been processed please return same to this office for filing, along with the insurance company's bond attached to our bond form. Upon filing the executed bond with this office, a copy of the City Council approval itself will then be issued to you for presentation to the Inspectional Services Department, which is located at 831 Mass. Avenue (next door to City Hall). Then the actual permit may be secured at the Public Works Department at 147 Hampshire Street.

We hope that this information outlining the bond and permit procedure will be of assistance to you.

shall faithfully observe and keep each and all the agreements, stipulations, conditions, specifications and provisions on his part to be kept and performed contained in said permit and in each and every extension of the same according to the full extent and spirit of said permit and the ordinances of the said City now relating or that may relate thereto, and shall indemnify and save harmless the City of Cambridge from all liabilities, damages, judgments, loss and expense whatsoever which the City may incur or suffer, arising out of the issuing of such permit and all extensions of the same, and from the construction, maintenance or operation of said.....

IN CITY COUNCIL

WHEREAS: This City Council is in receipt of a petition from Linsey Lee on behalf of the Cambridge Farmers' Market requesting permission to use the City-owned parking lot without charge located on Bishop Allen Drive and Norfolk Street on each Monday from the second Monday in July (July 10, 1989) to the last Monday in November (November 27, 1989), during the hours of 12 Noon to 6:00 P.M.; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That in accordance with the provisions of an ordinance relative to placing and maintaining signs, the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to Linsey Lee on behalf of the Cambridge Farmers' Market for the erection of a banner across Massachusetts Avenue at the corner of Norfolk Street from July 10, 1989 to November 27, 1989;

Provided that before erecting the above named banner the petitioner shall obtain a permit from the Inspectional Services Department and file with the City Clerk a satisfactory bond in the sum of Two Thousand (\$2,000.) Dollars conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the construction, maintenance and use of said banner; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to direct the departments concerned to grant the required permits and licenses pursuant to the request of the petitioner; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to direct the Commissioner of Traffic and Parking to waive all parking fees for the meters within the parking lot located on Bishop Richard Allen Drive and Norfolk Street and the surrounding areas for the purpose of allowing consumers to participate in the Farmers' Market during the period when the Market is being conducted and to take whatever steps are necessary, including the posting of signs, to ensure that the intent of this order is being carried out.

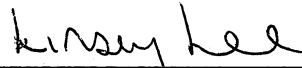
