Gentlemen: Enclosed please
find bill for Copper Sprinklers.
At the time Mr Docker
gave Mr. Brown the figure at \$18⁰⁰
it was understood that they were
to simply replace the Sprinklers
then in use, to be of the same
size and shape: the Sprinklers
as afterwards decided upon were
made considerably larger, necessarily
longer Arms, were material in
the shape and of course consid-
erably more labor in the con-
struction: the Sil for the
carts in Cambridge were not
as large as those going to
Lowell, and we have billed

them at \$20. and \$22. respectively. We could not possibly afford to bill them at \$18. even did you think we ought since I trust you will not for a moment they being so different from what was at first contemplated and costing us in consequence almost as much as we have charged. Trusting that our explanation, as well as the sprinkles will prove satisfactory to you.
