In Board of Aldermen, May 1. 1861.

Ordered,

That the Committee on Reservoirs and Drains be authorized and instructed, in connection with the Superintendent of Drains, to cause surveys to be made and plans of the streets of the City to be drawn and the sewers now laid to be delineated on said Plans. All said work to be done for the purpose and in the manner indicated in the Report this day submitted by said Committee; and that the expense thereof be charged to the Appropriation for Reservoirs and Drains.

Provided, however, that said expense shall not exceed the sum of Five Hundred Dollars.
