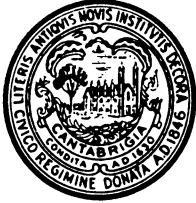

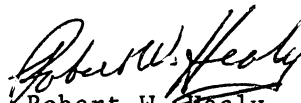

Attached is an order requesting the appropriation of a grant from the Commonwealth of Massachusetts Department of Public Health for \$106,950 to the Health and Hospital Services Salaries and Wages account (\$80,085), Other Ordinary Maintenance account (\$26,505), and Travel and Training account (\$360) to provide funds to continue the Women, Infants, and Children (W.I.C.)
