IN CITY COUNCIL

May 21, 1984

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to direct the Commissioner of Public Works to grant a permit to the Harvard Coop, under the provisions of Section 17-10 of the General Ordinances, to conduct an International Food Festival in conjunction with the Olympic Soccer Finals; said Festival to be held on the Palmer Street sidewalk in front of the Harvard Coop Book Building on Sunday, July 29, 1984 from 11:00 a.m. to 7:30 p.m.; and be it further

ORDERED: That this permit is granted subject to the condition that the petitioner, the Harvard Cooperative Society, by Haig H. Agababian, post a bond in an amount sufficient as determined by the Commissioner of Public Works to save the City of Cambridge harmless from all claims arising out of this permit and to specify any conditions or restrictions which he deems necessary to protect the safe passage and safety of the public in this area, and, further, to ensure that the licensee shall conform to all statutes and ordinances of the City now in effect.
