- WHEREAS: Some older residents of the Manning Apartments rely on the rear (Green Street) door of Purity Supreme for their grocery shopping, because of the much longer walk to the front door on Massachusetts Avenue, which can be hazardous in bad weather or winter; and
- WHEREAS: According to one report, Purity Supreme plans to discontinue its rear door, in favor of a new bakery; therefore, be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager, through the Community Development Department and the Central Square Committee, inquire into this situation, ascertain whether alternate arrangements can be made if necessary, and report the findings to the City Council as soon as possible.
