It has just been announced that Paul E. Dietrich has received the high honor of being elected into the College of Fellows of the American Institute of Architects; and

WHEREAS:

Paul Dietrich is one of the founding principals of Cambridge Seven Associates, Inc. which has gained an international reputation for design excellence since its inception in, 1962. He has played a major role in the development and management of this successful multi-disciplined design practice; and

WHEREAS:

As a principal of the firm, he has participated generally in the overall work of the office since it started in 1962. Of particular importance is his work in public buildings, such as museums, exhibitions, and projects related to transportation; and

WHEREAS:

He has been the principal architect in charge of such projects as the Whaling Museum in New Bedford, Massachusetts; Academic College II for the University of Massachusetts, Boston; Harbor Campus, a marine science center for the State of North Carolina; and a Solar Energy Exhibition in Washington D.C. for the Department of Energy; and

WHEREAS:

Currently he is involved in the design and construction of a large engineering office facility for Digital Equipment Corporation in Nashua, New Hampshire; and the new Porter Square Transit Station; and

WHEREAS:

During the past ten years he has actively participated in the community affairs of the City of Cambridge. He is a founding member and present chairman of the Cambridge Arts Council, a unique city-sponsored agency. As a member of the Cambridge Planning Board, he assists in the formation of city planning policy. He is also a member of the Design Advisory Group for the Kendall Square Redevelopment Area; and

WHEREAS:

Paul lives with his wife, Eleanor and their five children, Andrea, Kristen, Eric, Lars and Britt here in Cambridge where he and his family are active and dedicated members of the Cambridge community; therefore be it

That the Cambridge City Council extends our best wishes to Paul Dietrich on this occasion of this high honor in his career.

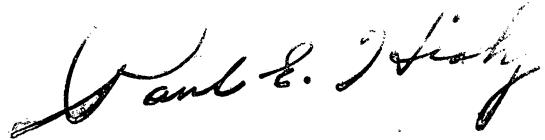
