COUNCILLOR WALTER SULLIVAN

- WHEREAS: The City of Cambridge desires to recognize the sacrifice of its citizens who have given their lives in the United States Military Services during wartime; and
- WHEREAS: The former Boardman School building on Windsor Street in Cambridge was dedicated on April 9, 1944, as the Lieutenant Lawrence D. Mahoney Recreation Center in memory of Lieutenant Mahoney who was called to his eternal rest while serving in the United States Marine Corps on September 22, 1943; and
- WHEREAS: The said building is no longer in use as a recreation center, and a more appropriate memorial should be designated; now, therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the intersection of Main Street and Portland Street be dedicated as "Lt. Lawrence D. Mahoney Square" in memory of the late Lieutenant Mahoney; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the appropriate city agencies to erect a memorial marker at this location.
