
I respectfully request that the following transfer of funds from the F-1 account be approved to provide the necessary money to meet the expense of the following account.

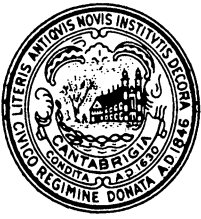
