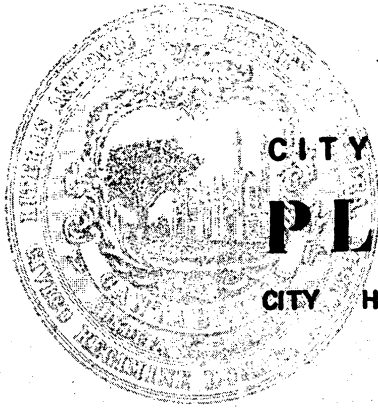

To the Honorable, the City Council:

SUBJECT: Acceptance and discontinuance of certain public ways in the Kendall Square Urban Renewal Area.

The Planning Board, at its regular meeting on June 18, 1985, reviewed the following requests made by the Cambridge Redevelopment Authority:

Discontinuance of a portion of Monroe Street, Main Street, Third Street and Carleton Street;

Change of use of a portion of Sixth Street and a portion of Carleton Street to pedestrian use.

Acceptance of widenings or improvements to Main Street, Broadway, Binney Street and the Mid-block Connector (formerly Sixth Street).

Granting of an easement to Fourteen Cambridge Center Trust along a portion of Sixth Street.

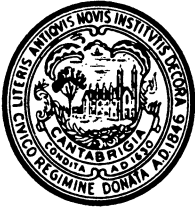
As the actions are in accordance with the adopted redevelopment plan for the Kendall Square area, the Board has no objections to the discontinuances and acceptances proposed. The Board does feel however that the point of land to be discontinued from Main and Third Streets should remain as open space when its final use is determined, and feels that the City Manager should have authority to approve its final disposition.
