- WHEREAS:** This City Council is in receipt of a communication from Caroline Bombar, Coordinator, Dollars for Disarmament, Disarmament Action Network, requesting permission to solicit funds in the City of Cambridge on Saturday, June 11, 1983 between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. in Harvard Square, the Porter Square Shopping Center, Central Square, Inman Square and at various points between the squares on Massachusetts Avenue; said monies collected to be used to fund activities of disarmament groups in the Greater Boston area and to promote the twentieth anniversary mobilization demonstration in Washington, D.C., on August 27, 1983; and
- WHEREAS:** On June 11th, the Disarmament Action Network plans to have small groups of individuals ask for donations from the general public and pass out "thank you" cards and informational literature in major commercial areas and will not interrupt in any way the flow of pedestrian and automotive traffic; and
- WHEREAS:** On this tag day on June 11th, sponsored by the Survival Education Fund of 727 Massachusetts Avenue, Cambridge, volunteers will be wearing identifying armbands with the logo "Dollars for Disarmament", as well as their names and the name of their local group and is a cooperative effort of ninety-two Greater Boston disarmament groups; now therefore be it
- ORDERED:** That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to direct the Commissioner of Public Works and any other appropriate City departments to grant the necessary permits to Caroline Bombar, Coordinator, Dollars for Disarmament, Disarmament Action Network, in order that they may hold this tag day on Saturday, June 11, 1983 at the above named locations.
