- WHEREAS: Ralph J. Darling was a sincere and dedicated public servant, who, when an extremely sad and sudden death of the former head of the Electrical Department occurred, was called upon to head the department and was appointed Acting Head of the Fire and Police Signal Systems in 1969; and
- WHEREAS: Ralph rose through the ranks of the Electrical Department by promotional examination and always exercised care and diligence toward his work; and
- WHEREAS: Ralph is the husband of Police Detective Louise Darling, another dedicated public employee who has helped many a disadvantaged or wayward individual; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending our deep appreciation to Ralph J. Darling for his 31 years of dedicated service to the city and to further wish him health and happiness in the future; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of said resolution to Mr. Darling on behalf of the entire City Council.
