IN THE YEAR ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY- ONE

AN ACT RELATING TO THE FEE FOR APPLICATION FOR A LICENSE TO OPERATE A CATV SYSTEM IN THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section nine of chapter one hundred sixty-six A of the General Laws, as last amended by section one of Chapter five hundred fifty-two of the Acts of 1977, no application for a license to operate a CATV system in the City of Cambridge, or for renewal, transfer, or assignment of such license, shall be considered by the issuing authority in Cambridge unless it is accompanied by an application fee of ten thousand dollars payable to said City. A licensee serving more than two hundred fifty subscribers shall, on or before March fifteenth of each year, pay to said issuing authority a license fee equal to five percent of the licensee's gross revenues for the past calendar year from all cable services in said city. For the purposes of this Act, gross revenues shall mean all forms of consideration, including initial lump sum payments.
