To The Honorable, The City Council:

In response to Awaiting Report Item No. 11, regarding a report on what regulations exist concerning construction vehicles and dumpsters and the length of time they may occupy parking spaces, Traffic, Parking & Transportation Director Susan Clippinger reports the following:

The Traffic, Parking & Transportation Department issues obstruction permits for construction vehicles and dumpsters which need to be parked on a City street.

The permit process includes a review of the following:

- that the location is safe for traffic and pedestrians;
- that the sidewalk will not be blocked;
- that the vehicle/dumpster cannot be accommodated on private property; and
- that the time the street will be blocked is as short as possible.

If the permit is being requested for longer than one month (30 days), the Department issues a one month permit with renewal depending on a determination by the Department that the extension is necessary and public safety is maintained.
