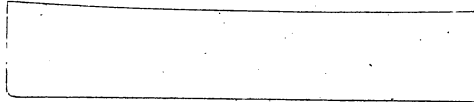

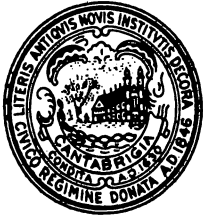


To the Honorable, the City Council:

At a meeting of the East Cambridge Stabilization Committee on April 12, 1979, a concern was expressed regarding neighborhood involvement in the 121A development process. The Committee passed a resolution requesting that a mechanism be established to assure neighborhood participation in the 121A process.

In a follow-up meeting of the East Cambridge Stabilization Committee held on April 19, 1979, the Committee passed a resolution to request that the City amend the By-laws of the East Cambridge Development Corporation as adopted by the City Council on April 2, 1979 to include: First, that all meetings of the 121A Corporation be public and advertised in accordance with the rules and procedures of the City Council; second, that all members of the East Cambridge Stabilization Committee receive notice of all corporation meetings including the purpose of the meeting; and third, that the corporation's relationship as stated in this amendment remain open to further amendment to secure greater participation in the 121A process by the Stabilization Committee.

I believe the above amendments will provide a broad representation of East Cambridge residents, as well as the public at large, with an opportunity to observe comment and participate in the proceedings of the 121A Corporation. I also believe that the attached amendments in conjunction with the stated purposes of the 121A Corporation, the stated boundaries of the corporation and the composition of the board itself offer the East Cambridge neighborhood maximum protection, participation and the assurance of responsible and responsive development.
