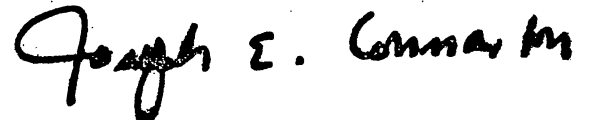

To The Honorable, The City Council:

Attached is an order requesting the transfer of \$19,060.00 in the General Fund from the Fire Department Salary & Wages Account to the Fire Department Other Ordinary Maintenance Account \$3,060.00 and Travel & Training Account \$16,000.00. The \$3,060.00 will be used to purchase nine (9) television monitors one for each station.
