Joyce, Co., Registered Land Surveyors (the "Plan") which Plan is recorded at the Middlesex County Registry of Deeds, Plan #609 of 1982, Book 14655, Page 364, Described as follows:

The "Driveway" referred to in the Master Declaration is the driveway extending from Sidney Street to Putnam Court the paved width of which is a minimum of eighteen (18) feet wide and is located within the strip of land the Southwesterly line of which is the Southwesterly boundary of lots 1,3,4 and 5 abutting land N/F G. Kaldro and the extension thereof to said Putnam Court and the Northeasterly line of which is parallel to said Southwesterly line and nineteen and 37/100 (19.37) feet distant Northeasterly therefrom and extends from said Sidney Street to said Putnam Court

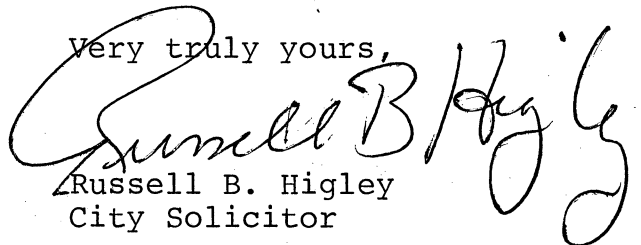
Dear Mr. Healy:
