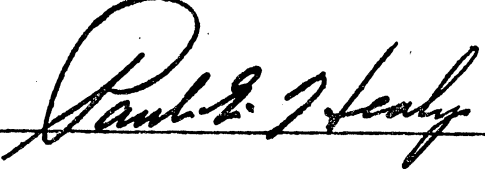

8) Procedure for individual driveway installation

- A) Send application to property
- B) Applicant returns completed form to DPW along with check for \$75.00, plan or sketch, and as otherwise instructed.
- C) The application and plan are then sent to the following for their review:

Public Works Department
Traffic and Parking Department
Historical commission
Inspectional Services
Neighborhood Association
City Council

- D) Upon approval of these departments and groups, the superintendent of streets proceeds with the installation as soon as it is feasibly possible
- E) The property will later be billed for any costs exceeding the \$75.00 deposit

An alternative method available to those who wish to expedite their driveway installation is as follows: After city council approval a contractor may perform the work. The contractor must obtain a permit to excavate the public way. See "Procedures for issuing permits to excavate the public way".

The property owner will receive a refund of \$75.00 upon acceptance of the driveway construction by the PWD.

CAMBRIDGE, MASS.

The undersigned respectfully pray that a driveway for commercial use may be ^{widened} ~~constructed~~ and agrees to deposit with the City Treasurer the sum of seventy five (\$75.00) dollars, subject to the following conditions, to wit: In case the amount so deposited is in excess of the cost of the driveway, the difference shall be refunded by the City Treasurer, but in case the cost of the driveway exceeds that deposit, said deposit shall be applied as a credit to the bill and the balance shall be paid to the City Treasurer within thirty days from the receipt of the bill.
