- WHEREAS: Ruth began her employment with the Library in September 1974 as a part-time shelver; and
- WHEREAS: In April 1977 Ruth was appointed to the position of Library Assistant I; and
- WHEREAS: Ruth was promoted to Senior Services Specialist in February 1985 and received a merit upgrade in 1990; and
- WHEREAS: Ruth was responsible for the selection of books for delivery to over sixteen senior housing sites as well as the selection of books for forty or more homebound individuals in the city; and
- WHEREAS: Ruth was the recipient of the Outstanding City Employee Award in 1998, and performed senior services and homebound job tasks, organized receptions for two hundred, upholstered chairs, made curtains when the need arose, and was a master at retrieving overdue library materials, using just the necessary mix of pleasant firmness to inspire borrowers to be responsive; now therefore be it
